The aircraft covered in this report were to coordinate with and cover the torpedo bombers on a strike on shipping in Futami Harbor, Chichi Jima. The first run was made against the shipping in the harbor. We direct rocket hits were scored on any of the ships. Three were short and may have caused demage but there was no evidence of damage reported. 3500 rounds of .50 caliber ammunition was fired at the ships with undetermined damage. Two rockets were fired at some barracks or warehouses. One warehouse, about 50 ft. by 150 ft., was hit and a small explosion observed. The second and third runs were strafing attacks on the anti-aircraft positions to assist the torpedo bombers. Domage was undetermined.
